OAC - Chapter 4765-20 Fire Service Training Programs

4765-20-07 Renewal of a certificate of fire training.

- (A) An applicant for renewal of a certificate of fire training shall meet the following requirements:
- (1) Submit a completed renewal application, on a form approved by the executive director, on or before the expiration date of the applicant's current certificate;
- (2) Continue to meet all standards for certification as set forth in section 4765.55 of the Revised Code and paragraphs (A)(5) to (A)(6) of rule 4765-20-02 of the Administrative Code at the level for which renewal is sought;
- (3) Completion of continuing education requirements as provided under section 4765.55 of the Revised Code and this chapter.
- (B) In deciding whether to renew a certificate of fire training, the executive director, with advice and counsel of the committee, has the following options:
- (1) The executive director shall renew a certificate of fire training for an applicant who meets all of the requirements listed in paragraph (A) of this rule;
- (2) The executive director may renew, refuse, restrict, suspend, impose a fine not to exceed one thousand dollars, or revoke a certificate of fire training for an applicant who fails to meet one or more of the renewal requirements listed in paragraph (A) of this rule.
- (C) An applicant for renewal must maintain records which are subject to audit by the division in accordance with rule 4765-22-01 of the Administrative Code, documenting completion of the applicant's continuing education requirements for the current and previous certification cycle.
- (D) There shall be no fee required for an application for renewal of a certificate of fire training.
- (E) A renewed certificate of fire training does not become effective until the expiration date of the current certificate.

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
